

From September 23 to November 1 you're invited to join others in a peaceful daily prayer vigil asking for God's protection of all human life through an end to abortion. Our prayer vigil now gathers just outside the 50 metre bubble zone limit (location on south side of Queensway across from the clinic). Go to the side door leading to hall to sign-in/pick up signs and read instructions on where the vigil site is this year.
