



Fourth Sunday of Easter WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

"Ask the Lord of the harvest to

send out labourers to his harvest" (Mt 9,38; Lk 10,2). In obedience to Christ's command, every World Day of Prayer for Vocations distinguishes itself as a moment of intense prayer, that absorbs the entire Christian community in an incessant and fervent invocation to God for vocations. How important it is for Christian communities to become real schools of prayer (cf. Novo Millennio ineunte, n. 33), capable of educating for dialogue with God and forming the faithful to open themselves ever more to the love with which the Father "so loved the world that he gave His only Son" (Jn 3,16)! Prayer developed and lived, will help us to be guided by the Spirit of Christ to collaborate in building up the Church in charity. In this context, the disciple grows in an ardent desire that all may encounter Christ and achieve the true freedom of the children of God. This eagerness will lead the believer, following the example of Mary, to be ready to pronounce a full and generous "yes" to the Lord who calls him or her to become a minister of the Word, the Sacraments and Charity, or to become a living sign of Christ's chaste, poor, and obedient life among the people of our time.

DAY PROGRAM

The day program runs from Monday to Friday. Children entering grades 1 through 6 in the upcoming Fall school year participate in four classes each day, attend daily Mass, learn the Mass parts and liturgical songs, participate in games, icebreakers, skits, songs, recess, and prayer. Our curriculum helps children to learn and be reinforced in important principles of their Catholic faith. Furthermore, Totus Tuus strives to help students be clear and consistent in their faith. College students who are on fire with their faith give the students living examples to observe and then imitate. This process teaches them that being a witness to their faith in the world around them is a very realistic and worthwhile goal. Finally, Totus Tuus endeavours to show children that the humble, yet courageous process of seeking Christ is a journey that must be aided by prayer and the Sacraments.

EVENING PROGRAM

The evening program runs from Sunday to Thursday and is designed for students in Grade 7-12 who are seeking to deepen their faith and grow in their personal relationship with Jesus. It is facilitated by our highly trained, collegeage Totus Tuus missionaries, with support from our Parish Coordinator. It begins with dinner, instruction, small group discussions, quiet meditation, prayer, and fellowship. The team teaches in such a way as to continually offer a dialogue by which each person feels respected in his or her most basic dignity.
