Must be registered in the parish for at least three months. A baptism date will be set after attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class.

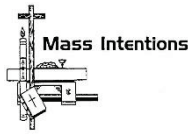
COMMUNION & ANOINTING FOR THE SICK:

MARRIAGE:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest one year in advance. At least one of the parties must reside within the parish boundaries or be a registered member of the parish and attending weekly. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY

When we see our life of faith as an organic growth in Christlikeness endeavouring to imitate him, think and speak as Christ would, love like Christ, serve like Christ – then we are true stewards of his mysteries, then we are living Christian stewardship in its most sublime and fullest meaning. It can be as simple as inviting someone to Sunday Mass or volunteering to car pool, spending time in a perpetual adoration chapel, organizing a parish bake sale, visiting the elderly or the ill, praying the rosary for an end to war, standing-up for the voiceless, bringing the Eucharist to a shut-in, forgiving an enemy, fighting injustices, lending a helping hand in the community, neighborhood, parish, defending the integrity of the Catholic faith from harmful ideologies and heresies, encouraging our young people in their discovery of God's plan in their lives and their unique potential. And the list goes on. It involves giving of ourselves and not counting the cost – all because we serve the King of the Kingdom which is all about truth and life, holiness and grace, justice, love and peace.

And so, I thank you, dear brothers and sisters, for your time and attention. As we celebrate our Eucharistic and Risen Lord Jesus, today, the Lord's Day, Stewardship Sunday, I encourage and invite you to give some extra thought this week to how exactly are we growing in love, virtue and service and how ready are we to go beyond the necessary sacrifices to be made, seeking even more importantly to find ways to give of ourselves, self-gift, which is much deeper, holier and truly the way Christ himself lived his earthly mission to save us.

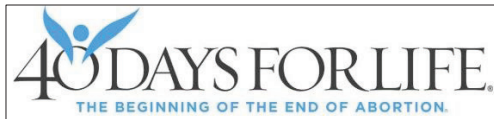

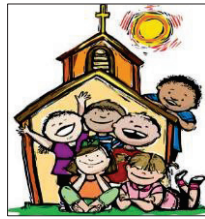


YOUTH GROUP
