NOVEMBER – THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS

As we know, All Saints Day, November 1st, recalls all those who are in heaven,

who have reached the port of salvation and who are eternally in the glory of God. All Souls Day remembers all those souls in Purgatory and who need and ask for our prayers as they are being cleansed and prepared for Heaven. All Souls Day, and the entire month of November, is also a blessed opportunity for us to reflect on our faith in Christ the Saviour and how we heed the exhortation of St. Paul: "continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling" (Phil. 2:12-13). It is a moment of generous and living intercessory prayer for those members of our family, friends, parishioners, ancestors and others we do not know but who need the charity of our prayer as they are being purified - but who are assured of their salvation. Furthermore, it is a month for us to think about our own journey here on earth and how we are preparing to meet our Lord when the time will come to leave all behind and enter eternal life after the Particular Judgement. We pray in the Holy Eucharist: "To our departed brothers and sisters, too, and to all who were pleasing to you at their passing from this life, give kind admittance to your Kingdom" (The Roman Missal, EP III, 2011).
