FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

The first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the liturgical year. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (paragraph 524) says,

When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming. By celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: "He must increase, but I must decrease."

The Advent Wreath is a popular symbol used as the focus of prayer throughout the season. The wreath is blessed, and one candle is lit on the first Sunday of Advent; another candle is lit every Sunday until all four candles are burning brightly. Purple candles symbolize our waiting, hoping, longing expectation for the arrival of Christ. A pink candle for the third Sunday reminds us that the time of Christ's arrival is fast approaching, and we must prepare. The act of lighting the candles banishes the darkness: a reminder of Jesus Christ, the Light who has come into the world through his birth, and who continues to shine brightly through his Church.

O God, as light comes from this candle, may the blessing of Jesus Christ come to us, warming our hearts and brightening our way. May Christ our Saviour bring life into the darkness of this world, and to us, as we wait for His coming. Amen.


