Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year C) STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY

On this 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time,

across the Archdiocese of Toronto, we are taking time to reflect on stewardship. More than just the giving of time, treasure and talent, stewardship is profoundly spiritual, deeply biblical, and eminently practical in daily living. In this Jubilee Year, stewardship takes on special significance. The call to reset, restore, and renew, reminds us that everything belongs to God and we are guardians and custodians. The Jubilee demands justice and release; stewardship recommends responsibility and reverence. Together, these challenge us to live with generosity, balance, and in service of God and one another.

During this Jubilee Year, we recall its deep biblical meaning—a sacred time of spiritual renewal. The Hebrew Scriptures remind us that everything we possess, our very existence and living, are, ultimately belongs to God (cf. Lev 25:23). The Old Testament Jubilee saw land returned, debts forgiven, and captives set free; it was a radical summons to trust in God's providence—to live not with clenched fists, but with open hearts and hands, ready to receive and to give. Our stewardship flows from this same disposition and dedication. We are not owners, but custodians of God's gifts (cf. CCC, 952).


